Parish Spirituality Group: The group meet once a month to discuss the gospel reading for the next Sunday. For enquiries call 3268 3040.



NEWS FROM OUR PARISH SCHOOL

School Review Process: Last week we welcomed three visitors who undertook a review of our school based on the National School Improvement Tool (NSIT). The initial feedback we received was very positive. A report has been drafted and once it is approved, it will be released back to the school. This report will help us to re-focus for the rest of 2022 and develop a strategic plan for improvement over the next 2-3 years. I look forward to sharing aspects of the report with you when it becomes available. Have a great fortnight ahead.

Taste of Prep: On Wednesday morning we welcomed most of our Prep 2023 students for a morning of activities in the Prep classrooms. This first experience in the school is the start of the orientation process for the children (and parents!). The children were amazing, and we look forward to seeing them again in Term 3 as their transition from Kindy to School gets closer.

We do still have a small number of Prep 2023 vacancies, so if you're speaking with families in the wider community who are yet to decide on Prep options for their children next year, please encourage them to call the school and arrange a tour with me.




