The state will be moving from "Green" to "Amber" on Friday 11 November 2022. Amber (Tier 1) means there are moderate rates of community transmission and Queensland is coming

off a wave or may be entering a new wave.

When the traffic light is amber, we recommend you wear a mask:

- if you are older or medically at risk
- if you're around people who are vulnerable to COVID-19
- · if required by a venue or household.


