Remember this week coming up is the **Presbyterial Ordination** of the three transitional Deacons. **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> July, 7pm @ St Stephen's** 

**Cathedral**. You are all welcome to join them in this beautiful sacrament live or via webcast -. https://brisbanecatholic.org.au/multimedia/web-cast-schedule/ Keep **Gerard, Isaac and Minje** in your prayers to strengthen their faith to serve the church of Brisbane as pastoral leaders. The Feast of St Peter and St Paul (29<sup>th</sup> June) is a traditional date for the Ordination of Priests. These two Saints demonstrate a unity in the mission to proclaim truthfully the Gospel to the world and the personal differences in the way they served, evangelized and lead the Christian community. St Peter's mission was to the Jews and St Paul's was to the gentiles – a broader audience. Both missions are equally important but not opposed. There is a wonderful sense of order and diversity that these two giants of Christianity remind us to be. Each one of us the baptized are called to serve, whether through being single, married, being a priest or a religious brother or sister.


