Hi all,

Thanks everyone who attended the Men's BBQ on Monday and listen to Fr Adrian Farrelly. His talk was titled **The Mass, me and imagination**.



Here's a little summary of what I heard. First of all the Mass is a beautiful sacrament and liturgy. Liturgy is two words - Laus (people) and Ergon (Work), So the liturgy is the work of the people. We are not meant to be passive spectators but full and active participants in the Mass. If we expect nothing when we attend Mass, there's a good chance we'll receive nothing. First - get to Mass early. When you get there pray for your fellow parishioners, the priest, readers, ministers of communion, ushers and musicians. Pray that everyone does their ministries well, for the issues and challenges that your priest and fellow parishioners has experienced through the week - Join in with the singing and praise God. Say your responses with conviction and let the Spirit fill you to overflowing and let the liturgy transform you. When you are listening and responding to each prayer, use your imagination, engage in their meaning and be conscious of your gestures (kneeling, standing, praising, reflecting etc). Think about what you are saying rather than going through the motions. Remember the words of the Creed and have a discussion with parishioners or people you run into. How can you apply aspects of the Mass into your faith life as an evangelising disciple?

It's a special day when the Church honours and recognises the important role that grandparents and elderly individuals play as they share the faith with their grandchildren and witness to Jesus through their lives.


