THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT 17 DECEMBER 2023

13-12-23 – 3rd Sun of Advent (Gaudete Sunday)

Hi all,

We are speeding towards Christmas. Rejoice in Anticipation

The readings for the Third Sunday of Advent fill our hearts with anticipation and joy as we journey through the season of Advent. Isaiah's prophecy paints a vivid picture of the Messiah, the anointed one, who comes to bring good news to the oppressed and proclaim freedom to the captives. This vision echoes through the ages, resonating with the deep longing of humanity for a saviour, a liberator, and a bearer of glad tidings.

As we listen to Mary's Magnificat, we are invited to join in her song of praise. Mary, a humble and obedient servant, exalts in the greatness of God's mercy and faithfulness. Her soul magnifies the Lord as she reflects on the extraordinary role she has been chosen to play in God's redemptive plan. In her joy, we find inspiration to magnify the Lord in our own lives, recognizing the blessings and grace He pours upon us.

Paul's letter to the Thessalonians adds a layer to our reflection. "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances," he exhorts. These are not mere suggestions but a roadmap for a life attuned to the Advent spirit. The anticipation of Christ's coming should fill our hearts with unceasing joy, a joy that is not contingent on our circumstances but rooted in our relationship with the Lord.

In the Gospel according to John, we encounter John the Baptist, the voice crying out in the wilderness, preparing the way for the Messiah. His humility and self-awareness are evident as he denies being the Light but points to the true Light that is coming into the world. John's role as a witness calls us to reflect on our own testimony. How are we, like John, preparing the way for Christ in our lives and in the lives of those around us?

As we reflect on these readings, let us embrace the spirit of Advent with open hearts. Let us rejoice in the anticipation of the Messiah's coming, finding inspiration in the joy of Mary, the exhortation of Paul, and the witness of John the Baptist. May our lives be a testimony to the Light that shines in the darkness, and may we prepare the way for Christ with unceasing joy and gratitude.
