CELEBRATING CHRISTMAS LIKE MARY

Dear friends, today is the fourth Sunday of Advent and the last Sunday before Christmas. The long-awaited light of God is almost here! In the Advent season, we prepare for the arrival of Christ, not only in the world but also in our hearts.

Mary serves as a role model for the ideal reception of Christ, as seen in today's Gospel. As we heard, Mary listened and sought clarity when the Angel announced that she would bear and give birth to Christ. Christ has given us his Word to listen to, reflect on, and be nourished in, and his Church to guard us. No doubt, welcoming Christ entails listening as Mary and David did today.

Mary listened and welcomed the message from the Angel despite initially being unsettled by the Angel's salutation. Friends, do we accept God's will quickly even when they appear too strange?
