Remember these last two weekends I'll be specially exorcising blessed salt after Mass Place your salt and water in containers on the tables at the front of the church.

Many Catholics attend Mass on New Year's Eve or New Year's Day out of tradition or habit, but not everyone knows why. In reality, the practice is more than a tradition and has nothing to do with the start of the secular New Year.

Every Jan. 1, the Catholic Church <u>celebrates</u> the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, a major feast day and a holy day of obligation, which generally means practicing Catholics are required to go to Mass that day or to the vigil Mass the night before. The Church's new year, liturgically speaking, begins with the first Sunday of Advent, so this isn't a celebration of the new year, but of Mary's unique role as the mother of our Lord.
