#### FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YR B WORD OF GOD SUNDAY 4 FEBRUARY 2024

St Paul is famous for his preaching of the Gospel. With a singular zeal, he dedicated himself to founding churches and then supporting them. He supported them by his presence and teaching as well as, famously, through sending letters of encouragement and advice.



In this weekend's second reading, Paul writes to the church of Corinth, reflecting upon the mission he has dedicated his life to. He recognises this mission as a call from God, arising from the commission he received from Christ. For him, to proclaim the Gospel was not an 'option', one possibility among many, but rather an obligation, the very purpose of his life. Paul fulfilled that obligation with unparalleled dedication. He is undoubtedly the greatest and most impactful evangelist to ever live.


While Paul's mission is singular and unrepeatable, he by no means bears the responsibility of proclaiming the Gospel alone. As a priest I can say with Paul, that I have the formal obligation to preach the Gospel. Others share in the work of formal preaching in various ways.

You too are called and commissioned to share the Gospel, by virtue of your baptism. While not all are preachers in a formal sense, each person is obliged to do their bit, according to the particular gifts that God has given them. Parents and grandparents are called to be diligent in passing on the faith to their children and grandchildren. Those engaged in business, witness to the faith by their integrity and values. Others show a special care in hospitality, or liturgy, or care for the poor and vulnerable.

The call of Christ is the call to be a 'servant to all'. Paul is a shining example of humble and dedicated service. May we too dedicate ourselves to the work of the Gospel and imitate him in his zeal and humility.

Jesuit priest Richard Leonard has degrees in arts and education, as well as a Master's degree in theology. Fr Richard did graduate studies at the London Film School and has a PhD from the University of Melbourne. He directed the Australian Catholic Office for Film & Broadcasting for 22 years. Dr Leonard is an Honorary Fellow of the Australian Catholic University and has been a visiting scholar within the School of Theatre, Film & Television at UCLA and a Visiting Professor at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome.

Fr Richard has served on juries at the Venice, Berlin, Warsaw, Hong Kong, Montreal, Brisbane and Melbourne International Film Festivals and he has lectured on faith and culture all over the world. He is presently the parish priest of North Sydney.

Fr Richard has been published in *America Magazine*, *Eureka Street*, *US Catholics*, is regular columnist with *The London Tablet* and is often on ABC Radio.

He is the author of 13 books including: *Where the Hell is God?* 

Hatch, Match Dispatch: A Catholic Guide to Sacraments What are we doing on earth for Christ's sake?; What's it All About? Living lives of faith, hope and love. The Law of Love: Modern Words for Ancient Wisdom His latest book, "Why God?" will be released early in 2024.






