THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT 3 MARCH 2024

Sin, repentance, mercy, and reconciliation are all significant themes during the season of Lent. We are called to renew our striving for a deep and genuine holiness of life. God calls each one of us to holiness because he loves us and wills our good.



During Lent we take up the disciplines which the church recommends to us. These are given to aid us in our quest for holiness. The three main disciplines of Lent are prayer, fasting and almsgiving (charitable giving). These disciplines allow us to bring our minds and wills more fully into union with the will of the Father, and to align our lives more closely with the life of Christ. Discipline is required, but it is not enough. We cannot attain holiness through strength of will alone.

Holiness is always the work of grace. God alone can work the deep healing that is needed in our hearts, minds, and souls; though not without our cooperation. The sacraments, especially the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation (Confession) are truly necessary conduits of God's grace. They are powerful remedies for all that ails our souls.

Dear brothers and sisters, in the lead up to Easter, please avail yourselves of the sacrament of Reconciliation. God offers his mercy to us in this rich sacrament and pours out his grace upon those who approach him with humility. I know that many have fallen away from the practice of regular Confession and may feel awkward or embarrassed to return. Don't be, all that you will find there is love and mercy.




