FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER 21 APRIL 2024

Most evenings I, like many others, sit down before the television and watch the ABC news. It is important to keep abreast of current happenings and issues in our society. Yet, in many ways, the news is an open window into the troubled and turbulent times in which we live. We see the reality of war in several places around the world and the potential for escalation.



Beyond this we see troubles in our own society, be they political, cultural, or social. Most of these issues have no apparent solutions. In watching the news, one needs to be careful that a sense of despondency and anxiety doesn't settle in. Or, at the other extreme, overwhelmed by the events we vicariously witness, we can experience compassion fatigue and so find ourselves indifferent. Is there a path between these extremes? I think the virtue of Hope offers us an essential starting point.

In this weekend's second reading, St John offers us words of comfort and hope, which are as relevant now as when they were first written. He begins with a theological point, namely the extravagance of God's love for His children. This should give us confidence to face the troubles of the world and consolation when those troubles impact us. He then points us to Hope. Yes, it at times seems that evil threatens to undo all that is good. It feels as though those who desire peace in the world and harmony in society have an uphill battle (and they do) - but in the midst of that struggle, God's plan is unfolding. It is not yet fully revealed.

How do we respond to the war in Ukraine or the Holy Land? Or, closer to home, the stabbings in Sydney, both at the shopping centre and in the Church? Neither with despondency nor indifference, but with prayer, compassion and with hope. We are children of God, and God's plan is for ultimate good. Now power on earth can thwart it.




Come and try Alpha


